We expect at least three of these projects to be completed over the academic half term. You can use your project book to record your work and to practise your spellings. You can also present your work in other formats, so be creative! Can you earn your half term certificate in recognition of your project? This half term our Science topic is '**Plants**'. Please carry out some research about this. You will have the opportunity to present your project to your class. Below are some ideas about how you could present your project-

- Draw and label a picture of the parts of a plant
- Write some sentences to describe the different parts of a plant; what are their functions?
- Make a 3D model of a plant- be as creative as possible!
- Go on a plant hunt and record all of the different plants that you can spot
- Grow your own plant, can you discuss what your plant needed to grow and what it looked like at different stages?
- Create a plant quiz, can you describe a plant and see if your teachers and friends can guess the name of it!
- Create a plant poster of all of the plants that you know or have researched
- Choose two or more plants and compare them; what is the same about them? What is different?
