We expect at least three of these projects to be completed over the academic half term. You can use your project book to record your work and to practise your spellings. You can also present your work in other formats, so be creative! Can you earn your half term certificate in recognition of your project?

Any projects that are completed can be brought into school on **Monday 7th April**.

This half term our Geography topic is 'Sun hats or Umbrellas?' Focusing on the different types of weather in the UK and further afield. Please carry out some research on this. You will present your project to your class at the end of term. Below are some ideas about how you could present your project -

- Research and draw existing weather symbols and even create some of your own!
- Create a weather wheel
- Monitor and record the weather
- Compare and contrast UK weather with another country
- Dress up in different clothes to suit the weather. For example what would you wear if you were in a hot country or it was a hot day? Take pictures and we will guess what weather you are dressing for!
- Make a collage using different materials to represent the four seasons
- Draw and label a country that you would like to live in. Why would you like to live there?
