We expect at least three of these projects to be completed over the academic half term. You can use your project book to record your work and to practise your spellings. - Choose and research a castle and present this information to the class.
- Design a poster/leaflet to persuade people to visit a famous castle such as Dudley Castle.
- Plot all the castles on a map of the UK.
- Design the interior (inside)/ exterior (outside) of your own castle. What would it look like? Will it have any special or unusual features?
- Imagine you lived in a castle. Write a diary entry to describe this.
- Choose two castles and compare them. What is similar about them? What is different?
